We send our greetings and our congratulations from across the Atlantic. As you celebrate of the 250th anniversary of the coronation of Princess Charlotte in 2011, Charlottesville nears the celebration of a milestone for our town, the 250th anniversary of the naissance of the City of Charlottesville in 2012. 249 years ago the City of Charlottesville was founded along Three Chopt Road, an old Indian hunting path worn in to create a major east to west thoroughfare. Although Charlottesville may be best known for housing both Thomas Jefferson's estate at Monticello and the University of Virginia, we have a rich and distinct history that dates back well before the American Revolution. Charlottesville is birthplace to the famed pioneers of the Northwest Passage Meriwether Lewis and William Clark.
